2014 Tournament Rules

1. Only members of the Green Country USBC Association are eligible to bowl in this tournament. **A minimum of twenty-one (21) games must have been bowled in this association for the 2013-14 season as of March 1, 2014 in order to be eligible to bowl in this tournament.**
2. Bowlers will use their highest average for the 2012-13 bowling season, providing they bowled a minimum of 21 games.
 - a. If the bowlers highest 21 game average as of January 1, 2014 is ten (10) or more pins higher than their highest average for the 2012-13 bowling season, then the bowler must use the January 1, 2014 average. (USBC Rule 319A-2)
 - b. If a bowler does not have a 2012-13 average, the bowler's highest average of 21 or more games as of the time they bowl their first event may be used.
 - c. In the event a bowler does not have a 2012-13 average, and does not have 21 or more games in one league, a composite average of all leagues shall be used providing they total 21 or more games as of the time they bowl their first event.
 - d. USBC Rule 319D (Reporting Prior Tournament Winnings) does NOT apply.
 - e. USBC Rule 319E (Average Adjustment for Entry) does apply.
3. USBC Rule 319A-3: Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average, thereby resulting in more handicap.
4. Bowlers may bowl multiple teams:
 - a. No more than two (2) bowlers may compete together more than once in any team event.
5. Bowlers may bowl multiple doubles and singles:
 - a. All bowlers bowling doubles event must bowl singles the first time they participate. Multiple participation in singles event is optional.
 - b. Bowlers must bowl the doubles event in order to bowl the singles event.
 - c. No doubles may pair with the same partner more than once.
 - d. Bowlers bowling multiple times in the singles event may only cash once.
6. If a bowler competes more than once in any event, the first participation in that event will be used for all-events, city champion, and the Dennis Gaunt Memorial Award.
7. All-Events prizes and awards will be on a handicap basis in each case. There will also be one award and prize for Scratch All-Events Champion. Any bowler who places first in the All-Events but has not entered and paid the extra fee is eligible for the Championship Trophy only.
8. Bowlers must have a paid USBC national membership as well as Green Country USBC membership. Membership status will be verified before bowling.
9. All teams will bowl in the order members are entered on the entry.
10. Handicap will be 85% from 220 based on individual series units.
11. All money for the three events must be paid with the entry form. All personal checks must clear before any event is bowled.
12. Prize Fee ratio at least one (1) prize for each six (6) entries in Team, Doubles, and Singles events. At least one (1) prize for every ten (10) entries in All-Events.
13. Bowlers must check in at the tournament desk at least 15 minutes before bowling. Any substitutions must be made at least 30 minutes prior to bowling. After the tournament schedule is published, no change will be permitted except for extreme emergencies.
14. Automatic Scoring is the official score. Changes must be made by a designated tournament official.
15. Unmarried grade and high school students who have not attained the age of 18 must have written consent of their parent or guardian in order to participate in this tournament. Said written consent must be on file with the tournament director at least one week prior to bowling in the tournament, unless the student is accompanied by their parent or legal guardian, in which case the consent form may be filed up to the time the student starts to bowl (USBC Rule 13)
16. USBC Rule 329 (Protests). Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament management in writing within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits in Rule 329.
17. SPOT AWARDS: Any bowler bowling 50 or more pins over their average in a single game will be awarded \$5.00. Any bowler bowling 75 or more pins over their average in a single game will be awarded \$10.00. Bowlers are limited to one award per set.
